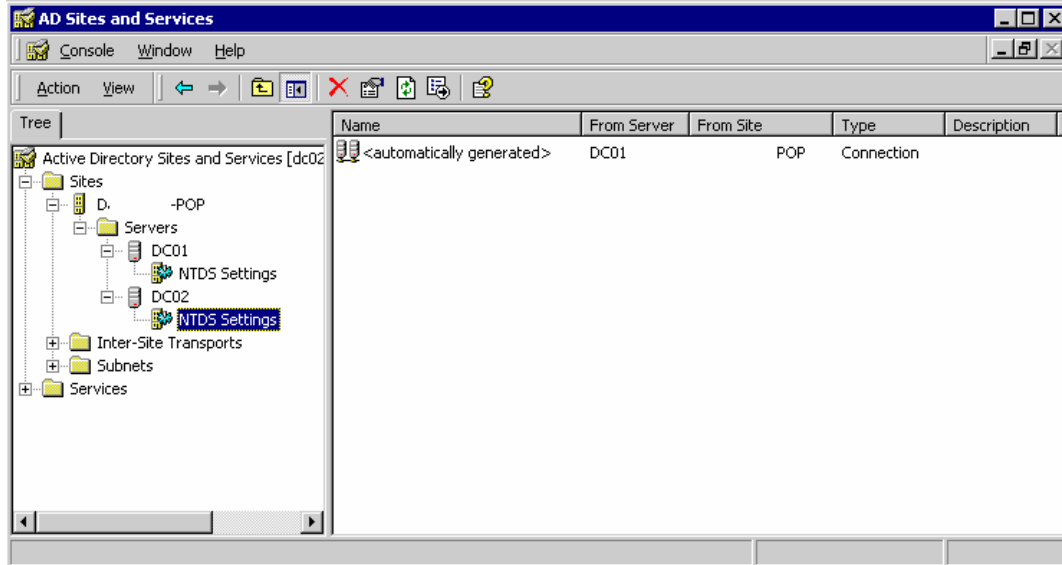
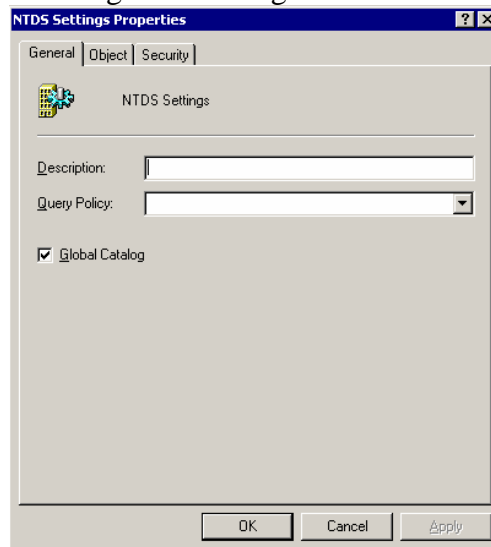


## Configuring Domain Controllers as Global Catalog Servers

- Logon to, or connect to (using remote tools) a domain controller on the network.
- Open Administrative Tools, and 'Active Directory Sites and Services'.
- Expand the Sites' container, and then the name of the site (for example, Default-First-Site-Name).
- Expand the server object which is the name of the domain controller you want to make a Global Catalog.
- Right-click the 'NTDS Settings' under the server name, and choose 'Properties'



- From the 'General' tab, there is a check box named 'Global Catalog'. Check this option to make the server a global catalog.



- In the right-hand pane, you will see as list of DC's this server replicates with. Select a domain controller in this list which is already a Global Catalog, right-click the object and choose 'Replicate Now'.
